

**Time Tables for South Dakota:**

You are not required to file a prelien, however if you would like to, we can send out a Notice of Claim document at any time before, during or after you have completed the job.

You get 120 days from your last date of work or shipment to file a Mechanic's Lien.

**Time Tables for North Dakota:**

You are not required to file a prelien, however, you do need to file a 15 day Notice of Intent prior to filing a Mechanic's Lien.

You get 90 days from your last date of work to file a Mechanic's Lien.

**Time Tables for Iowa:**

You need to file a prelien within 30 days of your first date of work or shipment. The only exception is when you are a subcontractor to the general contractor on commercial property, then you do not need to file a prelien.

You get 90 days from your last date of work or shipment to file a Mechanic's Lien.
